Parish councils often have local collection points for items such as glass, clothes and shoes. Check the websites above to find your nearest collection points.

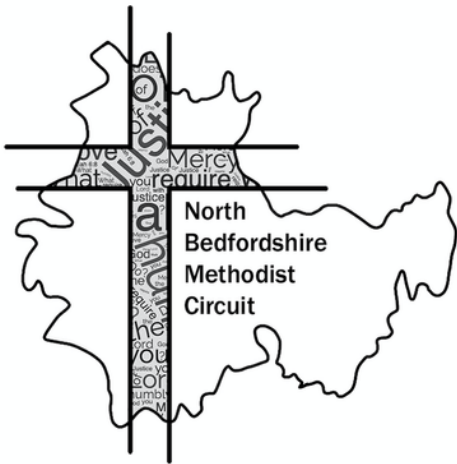
